Technical editing requirements for scientific article required for publication

To publish the scientific works in the conference materials, they must comply with the following requirements:

1. **The structure of the article:**

The first page must contain **UDC** (*Universal Decimal Classification*)

ARTICLE TITLE (written in capital letters);

THE NAME and First name of the authors (full);

Affiliation (scientific and scientific-didactic title, the position held and the place of work – for academic representatives; Name of the institution in which you learn PhD studies, the name of the Doctoral School, the year of study – obligatory for doctoral students;

ORCID (alphanumeric code of the researcher, registration link: <https://orcid.org/signin>)

Summary in English language (up to 250 words);

Keywords in English language (up to 7 words);

The actual text; Bibliographical references.

2. **Technical demands:** A4 format paper; edges: upper limit – 2 cm; bottom limit – 2 cm; left – 2,5 cm; right – 2 cm; volume – 7-10 pages; text printed at 1 spacing, with Times New Roman; letter size – 12; WORD format.
3. Figures, photos and tables which will be placed directly in the text should be of high quality. The order number and the corresponding legend should be indicated under the figure or photo. Tables should be numbered and must be accompanied by a title.
4. In the text, the references should be enumerated by number: [1, page 120], [2, page 333].
5. **The conference materials will undergo plagiarism detection to verify the authenticity of the submitted texts.**
